Reading Assignment: Chapters 1 and 2

Questions

What is your goal for this study (the entire study; not just week 1)? How do you believe God wants your life to be different at the conclusion of this study?

What do you think will be your biggest obstacle in achieving this goal? Begin to pray against this now.

The author uses many personal stories to teach how to share the gospel. Highlight any questions or statements in these stories that you think you might be able to use in sharing the gospel.

Role Play

Role play the following scenarios with your brother, sister, parent or friend.

- 1) How you would respond to a person that says you have to earn your way to heaven by good works?
- 2) Think of places you go where you are around unbelievers. Role play how to start a conversation and transition to the Gospel.

For example, you can say to the bag boy at Publix that walks your groceries to the car, "Thank you so much for helping with my groceries. Can I ask you a question? Do you consider yourself a good person? There is a good person test that you can take right now to see if you really are a good

person. Would you like to try it?"

Or you can say to the same bag boy, "Thank you so much for helping with my groceries. Can I ask you a question? Do you think eternal life is a free gift or something you have to earn through good works?"

Take Action

Pray and ask God to give you "divine appointments" to share your faith. Trust that He will supply what you need for any situation he brings to you in answer to this prayer.
